

Heart Attitudes for the Worship Choir

I. THE FOUNDATION: GOD'S GRACE & GOD'S GLORY

A. God's *grace* is the fuel for our worship.

1. It is by *grace* we have been saved (Ephesians 2:8-10):

“For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works so that no one may boast.”

2. It is by *grace* we have been gifted (1 Peter 4:10-11):

“As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God’s varied grace: whoever speaks, as one who speaks oracles of God: whoever serves, as one who serves by the strength God supplies – in order that in everything God may be glorified through Jesus Christ. To him belong glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.”

3. It is by *grace* we will bear fruit (2 Corinthians 9:8):

“And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work.”

B. God's *glory* is the focus of our worship.

1. We seek to draw attention to God, not ourselves (Romans 11:36):

“For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen.”

2. We seek God's approval over man's approval (Galatians 1:10):

“For am I now seeking the approval of man, or God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Christ.”
